

Hunting and Trapping Local Law

Hunting and trapping prohibited; exceptions

- A. No person except a law enforcement officer or duly appointed animal control officer acting in their official capacity, shall hunt or pursue wildlife with any weapon, trap or snare or discharge a firearm, bow or other hunting device within the Village of Dansville.
- B. This section shall not apply to a property owner on his or her own property or a person licensed to remove nuisance outdoor wildlife from removing such wildlife through the use of "live" or other "humane" trapping methods. The use of body/leg gripping or glue traps are not permitted.
- C. Actions taken to remove wildlife will be in compliance with the New York State Environmental Conservation Law.

Penalties for offences:

Any person convicted of a violation of this chapter shall, upon conviction thereof, be punished by a maximum fine of \$250.00 or by imprisonment for not more than 15 days, or by both such fine and imprisonment.
